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GENERAL ASSEMBLY, WHAT IS THAT?



As a member of Cedo Nulli you are always invited and welcome to come to the General Assembly (GA)!

You might wonder what a GA entails; why do you get so many documents in your e-mail? And what you're supposed to do with all this information? In this guide, the ways of our GA's will be explained, and you will hopefully be completely prepared to make yourself heard during this important meeting!

The GA is a meeting that takes place 3 times a year, usually in September, December, and April.

During this meeting, **members can ask question, share their criticism, and give opinions** concerning everything related to the association.

The Board will report to the GA.

This means they will update everyone present on their work since the last GA.

Besides this, they will reflect upon the **general** and **personal policy**, (more about this will be explained later!).

Did you know?

GA's are known to be quite long! The duration of an average GA can be about 5-8 hours!

Mind you, you can come and go whenever you want!

Just make sure to sign in by the Board and sign out when you leave.



Whenever members would like to speak, they should **raise their hand**. The President will then let you know when you can put your hand down and give you the word when it is your turn to speak. When being given the word, you can thank the president for the word.

When you mention another member, or you'd like to ask them a question, you have to refer to them as **Mister or Miss** [their last name].



BEHAVIOURAL NORMS

“I would like to put forward a **motion.”**

A Motion is a proposition that you make during the GA, which will be put to vote for everyone present. If you come up with a motion, the Board will have the chance to react to it and give their opinion. As the person proposing the motion, you will get the chance to react to the comments of the Board before the motion will be put to vote.

A Motion can be about anything you would like to see at Cedo Nulli, sometimes they are used to inconvenience the Board and entertain the rest of the GA, but more often they convey wishes of Cedo Nulli members in terms of policy.

When someone else proposes a Motion, everyone at the GA will have the option to add to this Motion. **Adding an adjustment** to someone else's motion is called **proposing an Amendment**. Everyone can add Amendments to a Motion and these Amendments will be put to vote separately.



VOTING

Did you know? Some motions become traditions and remain active during GA's, such as the tradition that the President has to wear pink loafers and the belt of a bathrobe during the GA.

"I would like to put forward a motion:
I'm hungry, so I'd like to have some bitter garniture prepared for the GA."

"I would like to put forward an amendment:
Please add some mustard, ketchup and mayonnaise to the snacks."

THE VOTING PROCEDURE

When something has to be put to vote, the President will ask the GA **if anyone is against the proposition**. If no one is, the motion is immediately accepted per acclamation (the slamming of a hammer).

If someone raises their hand, the whole GA will proceed to vote upon the matter.

During the voting procedure you will have to raise your hand for one of three options:

- a) **In favor**
- b) **Against**
- c) **Abstaining from voting**



COMMON TERMS & ABBREVIATIONS

DID YOU KNOW? THE GA WILL BE HELD IN ENGLISH, EXCEPT WHEN THERE ARE ONLY DUTCH-SPEAKING MEMBERS PRESENT.

THE BOARD/HET BESTUUR

THE BOARD HAS 7 DIFFERENT FUNCTIONS, EACH OF WHICH WILL HAVE TO REPORT TO THE GA ABOUT THEIR ACTIVITIES.

President / Voorzitter: The President is in charge of leading the GA, and in a managerial sense of the Board as well. The President is responsible for everything related to Cedo Nulli and is the spokesperson for the association.

Secretary / Secretaris: The Secretary is in charge of all the communication with members, the website, the minutes of the GA, and the non-commercial external contact.

Treasurer / Penningmeester: The Treasurer is in charge of everything related to Cedo Nulli's financial business. Questions concerning the budget and such can be asked to the Treasurer.

Internal Relations officer / Commissaris Interne Relaties: The Internal relations officer is tasked with maintaining the social aspects of Cedo Nulli as open, inclusive, and active as possible. Recruitment of members and the coordination of the Committees lie with the Internal Relations officer too.

Marketing Officer / Commissaris Marketing: The Marketing Officer is in charge of the promotion and branding for Cedo Nulli. This entails all promotional material, as well as Cedo Nulli's social media accounts.

Education Officer / Commissaris Onderwijs: The Education officer is tasked with all matters related to the ESSB. It is their responsibility to maintain our good relationship with the faculty. Other responsibilities include the organization of study groups and being a point to come to for members when facing issues with their studies/the faculty.

Commercial Relations Officer / Commissaris Commerciële Relaties: The Commercial Relations Officer is Cedo Nulli's voice towards external partners. It is their responsibility to acquire as much money for the association as possible, while concurrently making sure our partners align with our goals and values.

COMMON TERMS & ABBREVIATIONS

The Senate / Het Senaat: The Senate is made up of former Board members, it is an advisory organ within Cedo Nulli. This means they cannot prevent or cancel the decisions made by the Board. They are, however, always there to provide feedback and remind the board of how certain matters work. The Senate serves the GA and is there to constantly **guide and keep the Board in check.**

Each GA, the Senate writes a report. In this report they reflect upon the collaboration with the Board and add their views concerning the policy progress.

Audit Committee / De Kascontrole Commissie: The Audit committee is similar to the Senate, in the sense that it is an advisory board consisting solely of former board members. The difference is that the Senate is tasked with guiding the Board in terms of policy, whereas the Audit committee only **involves itself with financial matters.** The Treasurer is therefore in contact with the Audit Committee the most.

General Policy (Plan) / Algemeen Beleid(splan): Each Board is tasked with writing up their general policy. This is a document wherein the Board will provide the association with their vision on how to further develop Cedo Nulli and expand on what is already being provided. The Board reflects upon their policy plan each GA, and members are free to ask about all policy points included in this plan.

Confidant / Vertrouwenspersoon: Cedo Nulli has three confidants. Confidants are the people within the association you can reach out to when facing personal problems within or outside of Cedo Nulli. A Confidant will listen to your problems, try to guide you, and make sure your issues are properly dealt with. Two of the Confidants are Board members and one Confidant will be a Senate member.

H.T. & F.T.: These are terms which will be used quite often by former Board members and current Board members, especially around the September GA. In Latin H.T. stands for Hoc Tempore and F.T. stands for Future Tempore. This roughly translates to **Current Board (H.T.) and Future Board (F.T.)**. This means that when someone mentions F.T., this refers to the board that is currently not in office yet.

COMMON TERMS & ABBREVIATIONS

ESSB: Erasmus School of Social and Behavioural Sciences.

The Statutes / De Statuten: The Statutes of Cedo Nulli are a set of principles and rules to which Cedo Nulli has to abide. The Statutes were made by a notary in collaboration with the association and are **binding by law**. If the GA wants to alter the Statutes, a notary has to be hired to do so.

The By-laws / Het Huishoudelijk Reglement: The By-laws are an inhouse addition to the statutes. This entails that it is not binding by law, but it is the **rulebook** to which we at Cedo Nulli abide.

The Terms and Conditions / De Algemene Voorwaarden: The Terms and Conditions are something each Cedo Nulli member agrees to when they sign up. These are pretty much a set of expectations in term of conduct, together with the rights you as a member have.

The Strategic Plan / Het Meerjarenplan: You might hear this term being used during GA's and not understand what the difference is with a policy plan. The Strategic Plan distinguishes itself from the policy plan due to it being **a plan set up for five years**. It serves as a guideline and goal for where to bring the association in this timeframe. Each Board has to ensure the GA that they will work in line with the Strategic Plan and their policy should reflect this as well.
