POSITIONS

THE POSITIONS WITHIN EACH COMMITTEE

CHAIR

As the Chairman of a committee you are expected to guide the committee on the right track. You make sure that things get taken care of, that communication stays clear and that the board supervisor is up-to-date on the current state of affairs. Keep in mind that as a chairman you have more responsibilities than other members of the committee. So are you a responsible person who is capable of keeping an overview of what's going on? Chairman is the way to go!

TREASURER

As the Treasurer of your committee, you will be responsible for the budget. You will learn how to make an estimate and in the beginning of the year you will prepare an estimate for your committee. Sometimes it will be a real challenge and puzzle to let everything fit in the budget, but that's also the fun part. It's also your job to keep an eye on your committee members, so they won't spend too much (or too little) money!

SECRETARY

The Secretary focuses on writing the minutes during a meeting. This is an important task: the committee depends on you to read what they need to do. Besides this, you will be answering most of the e-mails your committee gets and processing the subscriptions for activities. Secretary mostly is more of a back-ground role but in most committees you can do some other tasks as well. So would you like to be the backbone in a committee? Become the Secretary!

COMMISSIONER OF PROMOTION

The Commissioner of Promotion is responsible for the promotion of the events a committee organises. You will promote the event and write a little piece of text to put on Instagram, create flyers and promotional video's (in programs such as Canva, Photoshop, InDesign and Illustrator) for an activity, and so much more! If you are outgoing, creative, have a lot of marketing strategies and all in all feel like you were born to be a Commissioner of Promotion, then search no more, apply for this position now!

COMMISSIONER OF EXTERNAL RELATIONS

As a Commissioner of External Relations you will be responsible for all outgoing contact that is not related to the university. In addition, you will be responsible for adding more contacts to the commercial relations system. Moreover, using these contacts you can come up with ideas for acquisition. In other words: if you add a lot of contacts and have a good plan of action, your committee may get their hands on extra budget! So, do you want to learn how to lobby and present yourself? Then we want you!



DIVERSITY AND INCLUSION COMMISSIONER

The Diversity and Inclusion Commissioner is not an independent position, but an added task for a person chosen within your committee. The task as a Diversity and Inclusion Commissioner is to make sure everyone feels included within the committee and during the events you organise. You make sure that all the events that the committee organises are accessible for everyone (also for international students) and you will be responsible for promoting more cohesion within the committee, for example by organising and stimulating activities to undertake together. Lastly, you will be responsible for the buddy system, so when someone asked for a buddy, it is possible that you are the one who are linked to that person. So do you like to create cohesion, include others and love to make new social contacts? Then you are the right person for this position!
